Correction

In June 2012 the Commission sent the Minister the ACT Greenhouse Gas Abatement Scheme—Compliance and Operation of the Scheme for the 2011 Compliance Year—Report 5 of 2012. On 23 August 2012 the Minister presented the Report to the Legislative Assembly.

In the Summary of 2011 outcomes on page 2 of that Report it was stated that “No participant elected to carry forward part of their liability to 2012”.

This statement is incorrect. Two benchmark participants elected to carry forward 10% of their liability to 2012.

This was a reporting error and the two benchmark participants complied with all aspects of their ACT Greenhouse Gas Abatement Scheme liabilities.
