I have just returned from a trip to my local Woolworths store with a brochure prepared by Woolworths. According to their example the price to the consumer for a case of 24 cans of soft drink will increase by \$2.63 (incl GST). They claim that it will cost them 9.94c per can to administer the scheme.
