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### COMMISSION PROPOSES 2018–23 WATER AND SEWERAGE PRICES

The ACT Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (the Commission) today released its draft decision and proposed price direction for regulated water and sewerage services prices. This draft decision proposes the amount of revenue Icon Water can earn, and what prices it can charge, over the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2023.

"As a result of Icon Water's operational savings, and the Commission's review of tariff structures, nearly all Canberra consumers will see immediate falls in their water bills", said Senior Commissioner Joe Dimasi.

"The Commission's draft report estimates that a typical Canberra household consuming 200kL per year will see a fall of 1.2 per cent (or about \$14) in their annual bill in 2018–19 compared to 2017–18", Mr Dimasi said. "After this initial fall in 2018–19, prices are expected to increase by around 2 per cent each year of the rest of the regulatory period, or approximately in line with inflation."

Estimated bill impacts for non-residential customers over the regulatory period range from -0.1 per cent to 3.6 per cent depending on water usage and the number of billable fixtures.

The key drivers of the proposed fall in water and sewerage services prices include decreases in Icon Water's forecast operational expenditure, with projected costs nominally flat across the forward period. The Commission's independent review of Icon Water's capital expenditure program also reduced the allowance for capital expenditure. This along with the current low interest-rate environment has also contributed to limiting tariff increases.

The Commission's draft decision on regulated water and sewerage services prices to apply from 1 July 2018 is for lower prices than proposed by Icon Water. The difference reflects the Commission's proposal to decrease the parameters for rate of return and imputed tax values from Icon Water's proposed values, and decrease Icon Water's proposed operating and capital expenditure based on the independent review.

The Commission is seeking comment on the draft report, and its findings and recommendations.
